On **Tuesday, April 25th, 8:00 PM**, we will finally be conducting our next in person BHCA General Meeting at the Colonial Church, located at Bell Blvd. where Luke Place and 216th Street converge. As usual we have invited our officers from the 111th Precinct, featuring their regular crime report. Recently we heard from our precinct's crime prevention officer that burglaries in the Bayside Hills area seem to have subsided.

Hopefully, he's not jinxing anything, but just wanted to bring you some good news. Obviously, we still need to be vigilant and by no means become complacent. In addition to our 111th Precinct report, we have as featured guests' members of the FDNY Fire Safety Education Unit. Topics covered in the presentation include, but are not limited to:

-fire facts/statistics

-common causes of fires (e.g., cooking, e-bikes, electrical, candles, heaters, etc.)

-proper usage of lithium batteries -smoke and combination alarms -knowing the type of building you live in



-escape plans, based on the type of building you live in -closing doors if there is a fire

-the importance of obtaining a fire extinguisher in your home

-overloading power strips

On Thursday afternoon, October 13, 2022, a meeting was conducted with the Department of Parks including its new commissioner, Susan Donoghue, Parks Capital Projects representative Eric Mattes, Matt Druary from Intergovernmental Affairs, Justin Argo, NYC Parks Department Administrative Park & Recreation Manager, BHCA Vice President Sebastian D'Agostino, other civic leaders, and myself. It was there that we learned the revitalization construction project of Captain Dermody Triangle will commence the Spring of 2023. Early this month we received word from the NYC Department of Parks and Community Board 11 that construction will begin sometime around March 20th. Please Be a Responsible Dog Owner

In recent weeks, it has come to my attention that many dog owners are not fulfilling their LEGAL and CIVIC responsibilities of picking up after their pets. As a dog owner who often walks two dogs and has had the unfortunate experience of stepping into a pile of poop, I am disappointed and appalled by this behavior. The inconsiderate give all dog owners a BAD REP!! Whether you are walking your dog on a mall, city park, near a lake or on a sidewalk in NYC it is your obligation to pick up and dispose of the poop properly!! If YOU are walking your dog in these areas, it is likely that another owner will be walking their dog in that area as well.

Furthermore, we rely on both landscapers and volunteers to clean up and maintain our malls. It is unkind and thoughtless to leave feces behind for them to step into!!! Your cooperation is needed to keep our neighborhood clean and beautiful. It is not just the neighborly thing to do. It's the law: **Dog Laws**

Failure to Remove Canine Waste

Each person who owns or controls a dog must remove any feces left by that dog on any sidewalk, gutter, street, or other public area and dispose of it in a legal manner. The person may remove the feces and carry them away with him/her for disposal in a toilet or their own trash container or trash bag. The feces may also be placed in a non-leaking sealed bag or container and deposited in a DSNY litter basket. The provisions of this law do not apply to a guide dog accompanying any blind person.
